<b>Endowments (in alphabetical order)</b>	<b>Endowment Distributions Used For</b>
<i>The Bereans Class Endowment</i>	Will be used for a designated purpose to be determined by the Bereans Sunday School class each year
<i>The Beverly Wilson Memorial Endowment for Missions</i>	Missions
<i>The Boswell Family Endowment</i>	Will support missions and children each year
<i>Blitchington Memorial for Youth</i>	Scholarships for youth retreats, mission trips, Confirmation retreats, and educational opportunities
<i>The Charles A. Bardin Counseling Center Endowment</i>	Will subsidize individual and/or family therapy sessions in cases where those in need of help do not have the insurance or financial means to fully fund the therapy they require
<i>Charles Wells Memorial</i>	General purposes – annual distribution to be used for local ministries, building needs, and missions beyond the local church
<i>Children’s Ministries</i>	Children’s Ministries
<i>The Children’s Ministry Worship Experience Endowment</i>	Will provide funding for RUMC’s weekly children’s large group worship experience
<i>The “Christians Under Construction” Fund</i>	A purpose determined by the donor (CUC Sunday School class) each year, or for RUMC general purpose needs if no specific purpose is documented
<i>Columbarium Endowment</i>	Maintenance and improvements of the columbarium located at RUMC
<i>Dale A. Rettke &amp; Sandra Rettke Nauman Fund</i>	RUMC Foundation operating expenses

<i>The Dennis and Chris Love Endowment</i>	RUMC's Worship Arts Ministry
<i>The Douglas L. Thomson Family Memorial Endowment</i>	Educational opportunities and local missions
<i>Facilities Endowment</i>	RUMC Board of Trustees purposes of facility maintenance and/or enhancement
<i>The George and Rose Jackson Polatty Endowment for Worship Arts</i>	The enhancement of the Worship Arts ministry and programs at RUMC
<i>The Georgia Hornor Witschy Memorial Help Fund</i>	Used to benefit RUMC's Help Fund or for other immediate needs (from disaster relief to individual/family assistance, to support of UMCOR, etc.) inside or outside of the RUMC congregation
<i>The Harry L. Hall Scholarship Fund</i>	A scholarship for a college, university, or seminary student who is a member of RUMC
<i>The Jean Cox Stevens Memorial Endowment</i>	Traditional music and worship needs at RUMC
<i>The Joan Wheeler Hagan Memorial Fund</i>	The enhancement of the Worship Arts Ministry and programs at RUMC
<i>KBE Endowment</i>	RUMCK scholarship and special needs education expenses
<i>Kathleen Kany Endowment</i>	Music ministry and the help fund for local missions
<i>Malone Dodson Endowment</i>	Supports Mentoring Ministries and RUMC Foundation operating expenses
<i>Mary Long Endowment for Concerts</i>	Support of the Sounds of the Spirit classical concert
<i>The Mary Ware Scholarship Endowment</i>	Designated for providing aid to the homeless, missions and scholarships to students who apply and are approved. Criteria and application requirements are determined by donor's family
<i>Mathews Memorial Endowment and the Matt Mathews Memorial Fund</i>	Youth mission activities, work groups/activities to construct and repair churches/religious buildings in the U.S. and abroad, support of foreign missions, to contribute to the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR), and for the care and aid of the homeless
<i>The Medley Family Endowment</i>	Determined by the Donor each year
<i>The Mosteller Family Memorial Fund</i>	RUMC debt reduction – if no RUMC debt exists, to be used for trustee items, local missions, or financial aid to church members
<i>The Nell Calhoun Memorial Endowment</i>	Support of traditional and classical music programs and needs at Roswell United Methodist Church
<i>The Ora Coleman Memorial Endowment</i>	RUMCK petting zoo, RUMC's operating budget and animals for Morning/Evening in Bethlehem

<i>The Randall and Evelyn Jones Memorial Endowment</i>	Will be used to provide scholarship money each year for Divine Providence Training Center seminary candidates in Kenya, Africa
<i>The RUMC Congregational Endowment</i>	RUMC's general purposes
<i>The Roswell United Methodist Preschool and Kindergarten Endowment</i>	Will be used where needed each year for the purposes of enhancing the educational program provided by the school
<i>The Smiley Family Endowment</i>	RUMC's general purposes
<i>Suzanne W. Lewis Memorial for Youth</i>	Youth Ministry
<i>The Tatum Family Endowment in honor of James Roosevelt and Annie Mae Burt Tatum</i>	50% RUMC Worship Arts Ministry/50% RUMC Help Fund or 100% as needed for the Tatum sponsored stained glass window maintenance/repair in the East Narthex
<i>William W. and Hattie Lou Brewer Endowment</i>	RUMC's general purposes or maintenance/repair of the Brewer Family sponsored stained glass window in the RUMC Sanctuary
<i>World and Local Missions</i>	World and local missions
