I am thankful that our church is growing with people who want to live a Christ-centered life. Together, we help people live a Christ-centered life through Worship, Community, and Outreach, and we make Roswell UMC a place where community and faith can flourish.

Today, your help is needed to open a new door that will invite people into community with Christ and with our neighbors. The Commons Project will provide an inviting green space to expand capacity for outdoor gatherings, welcome community, and encourage outreach. Additionally, a new classroom building will provide much needed large Sunday School, support group, and community group space. We have worked to refine the plans for The Commons and surrounding areas to make it accessible, inviting, and an integral centerpiece of our campus: a space for community and faith.

Now it's time to move forward and expand needed classroom capacity and develop additional uses with The Commons area for children, young people, families, and seniors in the church and in the community. The total project cost is 5 million dollars, and the goal to reach 1.25 million dollars in cash by August 1 in order to begin construction by September 1. If we can build over the winter, we will have our new Commons area, classroom building, and activity areas completed in 2023.

These improvements can be a visible sign that people matter to God and they matter to Roswell UMC. This is a beautiful space designed for a world that is longing for Good News.
