Every applicant is required to take a technology assessment test to provide us with the level of technical knowledge they possess. The applicants with little or no knowledge of technology start in a 7 Saturday program called Information Technology Fundamentals (ITF). During that program, they can decide on their career choice of Cybersecurity or Data Analytics.

Both Cybersecurity and Data Analytics programs are conducted on 12 Saturdays after the end of the ITF program. The applicants with sufficient knowledge of technology which is observed through the initial assessments can go directly to their chosen programs.

The tuition for each one of the aforementioned programs is \$500; therefore, the maximum cost of the programs is \$1,000. Of course, the programs for single mothers, with certain requirements, could be free.

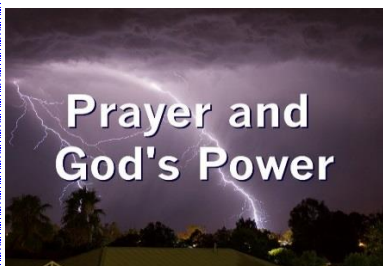
