### **7:00 – 8:00 p.m. -God's Talking Workshop!**

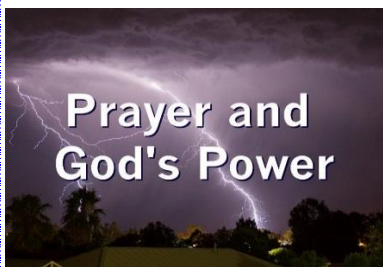
