Have You Considered a Small Group?

During your transition, have you ever said to yourself "I wish I had someone to talk to that understands what I'm going through?" God designed us for community and the career transition process is a time when it is crucial not to try to go it alone. A Small Group provides an opportunity to connect with others in a similar season of life.

Purpose

To provide a structure and Facilitator for a small group of individuals to build relationships through shared experiences for support and accountability during their job search. As stated in Proverbs 27:17, "Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another."

Meetings

The Group meets weekly for five weeks via Zoom. ***The next Group begins Tuesday, April 30 at 7:00 – 8:00 EST with subsequent meetings at the same time on Tuesday May 7, 14, 21, and 28.***
